



## Mobility to Daugavpils Secondary School No.13, Latvia October 5 – 9

### General information:

1. **When arriving to Latvia one needs to fill in Covid Pass form** (The form has to be completed within 48h before crossing the border of the Republic of Latvia): <https://www.covidpass.lv/en/> ;
2. When sitting on the outside terraces of the cafes one doesn't need to have a certificate. Masks should be worn inside all institutions, shops, transport.

For each task, the portal has several variants and explanations of answers, which help the child to learn the topics and ensure a self-directed learning process. Uzdevumi.lv also offers training tasks for state tests, which provide support to the child before diagnostic works and exams. The teacher can create and send online homework and tests to the students on the portal, and the parents can follow the child's progress and learning outcomes.
