Teachers celebrated the coordination meeting on **Wednesday 17th and Thursday 18th of november 2021** during the mobility organized by Budapest-HUNGARY. We talked about the planned points:

1- Virtual mobility for students next Wednesday 24 nov, organized by Hungary

The coordinating teachers from Hungary, Zsuzsanna Gyenizse and Elena Zdravkova , informs us about the programme: we have to prepare comics and posters about the topic planned, Robotics at schools.

The teachers responsible of the activity are working on the products. The videoconference will be next November 24 from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. in Belgium, Hungary and Spain, one hour more in Latvia and Greece and 2 hours more in Turkey.

The organizing teachers of this activity will send us the day before, the program and the zoom link for the videoconference. The students have been working on the activities and they will collaborate by shared rooms in zoom and on the jamboard. They will also do a collaborative activity by the twinspace.

The Belgian teachers tell us that they can't participate because the situation at the school due to the covid is not good. Despite that, they have made products and will post them on the twinspace



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2- Programme and activities in Greece 14 to 18 February 22 : accomodation and Budget

The Greek coordinator provided us information about the accommodation and the programme C5. We decided move students to Greece but not with family accommodations, everybody will be to the cheaper hostel, due the covid 19.

The coordinating teacher from Greece informs us of the difficulty of finding a hotel where we can all stay together, since we are a very high number, teachers and students. Probably we will be in two hotels. Every country will move 2 or 3 teachers and at least, 6-9 students.

On the other hand, for all countries it is difficult to know the number of students who are going to travel, which makes it more difficult to make a reservation. Latvia informs that they don't know the number because to travel they need to be vaccinated and some students are not. Hungary informs that the government has forbidden that student travel abroad and that one special permission must be requested, if they want to travel.

In general, to check-in at the airport, you need the European vaccination certificate.

The greece coordinator will send us the information of the hotels to make reservation.

We have opened a document to add the information of students and teachers from each country who are going to Greece.

About the Programme, all countries ask that activities be done outdoors and not indoors, with all sanitaries precautions

3- Programme and activities in Spain 28 March to 1 April: accomodation and Budget

For Spain it is the same question about accommodation. Any hotel has enough rooms for the whole group. Only one hostel has but 25% of the total amount has to be advanced.

On the one hand, the number of people or rooms is not known and, on the other, it is a very high amount to be able to advance the school.

The coordinator of Spain said that she will inform about the hotels in the city-center in Valencia and that each school, when it knows who is going to travel, makes the reservation directly by booking. Hotels are near the metro to go to the school in Manises.

The spanish teachers are planning the mobility and they are thinking on the Budget and the health conditions for students and teachers.

4- Final meeting in Turkey 20 to 24 june, with students

The coordinator of Turkey informs that on those dates there will no longer be classes, but that we can do outdoor activities and continue working on the project objectives. Although the virtual mobility was done last year, we can do a real and face-to-face mobility with students that also will be to close the Project



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The problem with accommodation is the same as in Greece and Spain, any hotel has enough rooms for such a high number of participants. So we need to host in two hotels at least.

The coordinator will send us information about the hotels and how to make reservations

5- Mobility tool: to update

We have updated the mobility tool with the data of the different participating schools

6- Blog: update

All participating schools have to post on the project blog about how they are developing the different activities in their schools. At least one entry every month.

And update the diary page of each school

7- eTwinning activities

The project coordinator reminds the schools that they have to publish the products of each virtual mobility in etwinning

8- Evaluation of the mobility Hungary

Hungarian teachers will create and publish online questionnaires for the evaluation of virtual mobility on November 24, for students and teachers
